Therefore your total outstanding fee will be VT36,000.

In the event I lose or misplace my business licence, how much would it cost me to get a reprint?

A business licence reprint will cost you VT1,500.

What are the requirements for a change in business name?

- You need to register the new business name with VFSC.
- 2. Inform us in writing and attach the following documents:
- Original business licence certificate.
- Copy of the new business name certificate.
- Copy of the approved VIPA certificate (foreign investors only).
- 3. The change will cost you VT1,500 and you will be issued a new custom tax (CT) number.

How do I get an additional category in my business?

- Submit an application with the appropriate documents as referred to in Table
 1.1
- 2. Foreign investors are required to provide a copy of the VIPA variation approval.
- The cost of the additional category will be charged on a pro-rata if the application is submitted during the year and will be assessed as follows;

Category * No. of months / 12 D2 * 6 / 12 10,000 * 6 / 12 =VT5.000

What are the requirements for transfer of ownership?

1..Submit a business licence application form with following documents;

- The original business licence certificate.
- Letter from previous owner authorizing the transfer of ownership.
- Sale and Purchase Agreement.
- Copy of the new VFSC certificate.
- Depending in the nature of the business, additional documents may be required (Refer to Table 1.1).
- 2. Foreign investors are also required to submit the following documents:
- VIPA variation approval for existing investors.
- VIPA approval certificate for new investors
- 3. The change will cost VT1,500; if the previous owner agrees to transfer the business licence fee to the new owner.
- 4.If not the fees will be charged as a new business on pro rata basis.(Refer to Table 1.1)

What do I need to do if there is a change in the type business entity?

- 1. Submit a business licence application form with the following documents;
- The original business licence certificate.
- Copy of the new VFSC certificate.
- Foreign investors are also required to submit VIPA variation approval.
- The change will cost you VT1,500 and you will be issued a new custom tax (CT) number.

What do I need to do if there is a change in the business location and how much would it cost?

- 1. For a change in the business location, you need to;
- Inform us in writing
- Surrender the original business licence certificate
- 2. Foreign investors are also required to submit VIPA variation approval

3. The change will cost you VT1,500

Do I need a business licence for a new outlet?

- 1. Submit a business licence application form with the following documents;
- Copy of VFSC certificate if a new trade name is used.
- Depending on the nature of the business, additional documents may be required (Refer to Table 1.1).
- 2. Foreign investors are also required to submit VIPA variation approval
- 3. The fee for the new outlet will be charge on a pro-rata if the application is submitted during the year and will be assessed as follows;

BUSINESS LICENCE



Business licence

Do I need a licence to establish a business in Vanuatu?

Any individual(s) or company that intends to carry out any business activity for the sole purpose of making profit must obtain a business licence (BL). Business licence is administered under the Business Licence Act No.19 of 1998.

How do I obtain a Business Licence?

- 1. Complete a business licence application form with the following documents:
 - A Business Name (Trade Name)
 Certificate or a Certificate of Incorporation (Limited Company) from
 Vanuatu Financial Service Commission (VFSC). It is not required if
 you intend to trade under your
 name.
 - Depending on your business nature, you may be asked to submit additional documents if required (Refer to Table 1.1).
 - Application forms are available at the Taxpayer Services Office in Port Vila, Luganville and Lenakel or it can be accessed from the website: <a href="https://customsiplandrevenue.gov/ull.customsiplandrevenue.gov/ul

 2. Foreign investors are also required to sub-
- mit Vanuatu Investment Promotion Authority (VIPA) Approval Certificate.

What do I need to renew my business licence?

- 1. Completed business licence application form.
- 2. Attach the following documents:
- A valid copy of VIPA Certificate for foreign investors only.
- A valid Business Name (Trade Name)
 Certificate that can be obtained from
 Vanuatu Financial Service Commission
 (VFSC). But this is optional; if you wish
 to trade under your name then the business trading name certificate is not required.
- 3. Depending on your business nature, you may be asked to submit additional documents if required.

How much does a new business licence cost?

- 1. A basic fee of VT10,000 is charged on each business activity under each category except for activities under categories J,K and
- 2. The same fee will also apply for each location

- Fees will be charged on a pro-rata basis for applications that are lodged during the year.
- 4. For example, if you lodge a new business licence application in the month of June.

BL = Category fee * Remaining No. of Months / 12

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= D2 * 6 / 12
=10,000 * 6 / 12
= VT5,000
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How much does it cost to renew a business licence?

- 1. For renewals, business licence fees are charged according to the previous years gross turnover.
- 2. If there is more than one category being renewed, the business licence fees will be charged on the turnover of each category For example, if you operate a business with two categories—C (Construction) & D2 (Retail shop) and your total turnover is VT6 Million.

Your BL fees will be charged as follows:

- Separate the total income—C (VT 1Million) & D2 (VT5Million).
- C—VT10,000 + D2—-VT20,000 = VT30,000.
- Refer to fee schedule on page 8 of the application form for turnover and corresponding fees.

Turnover: VT0—VT3,999,999 = VT10,000 VT4.000.000—VT9.999.999 = VT20.000

3. Where a new category is added during renewal, a basic fee of VT10,000 will be charged.

Are there any penalty fees for late business licence renewals?

1. A penalty fee of 10% will be charged every month on the principal fee.

Eg. If your principle BL fee is VT30,000 and you're late by 2 months, the penalty will be 30,000 * 20%(for two months) = VT6,000
